



Caldwell College Student Airfare Grants Summer Seminar Fanjeaux, France

WHAT: Two **airfare travel grants** plus **\$1,000 towards tuition costs** are available for Caldwell College students to participate in the annual summer study program that is held in Fanjeaux, France, and ends with four days in Paris. The study program, which is worth three (3) credits, welcomes participants of all religious affiliations. These grants are made possible and awarded by the Office of the President.



WHERE: Fanjeaux, France (and four days in Paris)

COST: Includes tuition and daily excursions, full room and board in Fanjeaux, tips for bus driver and kitchen staff, partial board (breakfasts and a farewell dinner) in Paris, and museum entrances. Airfare of approximately \$1,500 (from Newark Liberty International Airport) is an additional cost and will be paid for by this grant.

The Summer Study Program in southern France is for students of Dominican colleges and universities. A Seminar Program for faculty/staff is offered during the same time frame. Mornings are spent in study, afternoons in excursions to historic sites in southern France with a focus on places significant in the early history of the Order of Preachers. As a community of learners, we enjoy simple living and good meals at the Belvedere, a Dominican guest-house. Both programs conclude with four days in Paris. In your three-credit course, "France in the Middle Ages," students learn about the history, philosophy, art and literature of the period, both in class and on field trips.

You will visit many interesting sites in southern France, including places that are special to the Dominican Order's early years. Proposed plans for the daily tours from Fanjeaux include Prouilhe, Toulouse, Carcassonne, Albi, Collioure (on Mediterranean), Montségur, Grottes de Niaux (prehistoric paintings), and Chateau de Puilaurens.

Criteria for selection of the Caldwell College Student Airfare Grant for the Summer Study Program:

- ◆ A full-time member of the Caldwell College student body interested in participating and advancing the College community's dialogue about the Dominican mission and tradition.
- ◆ Completion of application in a timely manner.
- ◆ A **minimum** GPA of 2.5
