Two Course Offerings:

IT 341D, Seminar in Naples: This short-term study abroad/travel course will enhance the understanding of ancient and contemporary Italy by examining ruins of the Roman civilization (Pompeii), viewing the palaces of the Middle Ages and Renaissance, and observing contemporary Italian city life in the vibrant and culturally rich former capital of the region, Naples. Daily excursions are guided by knowledgeable and accredited tour guides. Readings on the history are done before and during the trip. Upon return, there is a short research paper.

SO 341D, The Italian American Experience: This course explores the great Italian immigration to America that occurred from 1880-1924 from a sociological perspective. Through lectures and historical tours of Naples and the surrounding area, students will gain an appreciation of the causes and consequences of Italian immigration.

- Fulfills the Sociology major or minor, Criminal Justice sociology cluster course, or the Social Science Foundational Core for education majors.

Led by Dr. Sally Jo Weber (Department of Modern Languages) and Dr. Rosann Bar (Department of Sociology & Criminal Justice) with Gaetano Salemi, a frequent visitor and lecturer at Caldwell University.

This trip will take us to the beautiful port city of Naples, once the capital of the "Two Sicilies", which is located in central Italy. The trip includes visits to Caserta (the "Versailles" of Italy), Pompeii, Sorrento, Paestum, and the Amalfi Coast.

Total cost includes roundtrip airfare from JFK on Alitalia, train transfer in Italy (Rome - Naples), 8 night accommodation, local transportation, local tour guides, entry fees, and some meals.

Applications must be submitted to the Center for Student Success with a \$300 non-refundable deposit by 12:00 p.m., Friday, September 26, 2014 to secure your place.
